Here are ways people can be involved:

- **Come and talk to us:** We will be out talking to the community at local events, markets and shopping malls. All of the events are listed on the webpage.
- **Map your thoughts:** You can drop a pin on a map or draw on a hard copy of the map and let us know any routes you think should be added, removed or improved and any problem areas.
- **Tell us more:** There is both an online survey and a hard copy feedback form with a few questions to help us set priorities.
- **Share your ideas:** Get creative and enter your own ideas on how to get more people riding bikes in Tauranga. People can vote on these and share ideas.

Everyone who gives feedback enters the draw to win one of two bikes up to the value of \$1000, by sharing your feedback on the brochure or online.
